Letters of support must be accompanied by an MOU and/or a clear statement from partners regarding the collaboration. Preference is given to organizations and agencies that provide signed Memoranda of Understanding in lieu of or in addition to letters of support. Memoranda of Understanding should detail how the applicant intends to collaborate with other victim service providing agencies within the systems of care available for victims in the District.
