DC Flood Resilience Community Walk Project

The Department of Energy and Environment (the Department) seeks eligible entities to lead two community walks targeting the Watts Branch and Oxon Run neighborhoods of Wards 7 and 8. These communities are increasingly vulnerable to flooding and climate change. The walks will build community resilience to future flooding, help the public understand the risk of flooding, and mitigate that risk. The amount available for the project is approximately \$19,445.
