



Pursuant to Mayor's Order 2011-170, dated October 5, 2011, the Office of Partnerships and Grant Services (OPGS), in consultation with the Office of the Legal Counsel's Ethics Counselor, is publishing the District's Third Quarter Report on Donations for Fiscal Year 2020. The Order requires OPGS to review all requests by District officials to solicit or accept donations and approve or disapprove such requests as appropriate in accordance with the Rules of Conduct Governing Donations (Mayor Memorandum 2015-001) and D.C. Official Code Sec. 1-329.01 (2001). This report includes data on all donation requests approved by OPGS for the period beginning April 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2022. During this period, OPGS approved the solicitation and acceptance of \$2,921,969.66 in donations of which \$220,556.12 represented financial contributions, \$2,592,761.54 were in-kind and \$108,652.00 were other contributions which is a combination of in-kind and financial donations.
