## Fiscal Year 2022 Victim Services and Supports Request for Applications

The Office of Victim Services and Justice Grants (OVSJG) announces the availability of \$16,270,000 in FY 2022 grant funds for community-based organizations providing services and supports for victims of crime.

**Purpose/Description:** Funding is available for:

- 1. Housing and temporary expansion of services for victims of domestic violence as a result of COVID 19 up to \$12,000,000
- 2. Flexible funding to meet the individual needs of victims of domestic violence, sexual assault, stalking or human trafficking such as, housing, food, transportation, or other temporary or immediate expenses, needed as a result of COVID 19 up to \$3,000,000.00
- 3. Housing for victims of domestic violence who identify as LGBTQ+ up to \$350,000
- 4. A Trauma Response and Community Engagement Program (TRCEP) site up to \$470,000.00
- 5. A partnership between a hospital based violence intervention program (HVIP) and a victim legal services provider to provide legal services for HVIP participants up to \$450,000.00

**Eligible Organizations/Entities:** Any public or private, community-based non-profit agency, organization, or institution located in the District of Columbia is eligible to apply. For-profit organizations are eligible but may not include profit in their grant application. For-profit organizations may also participate as subcontractors to eligible agencies.

**Length of Award:** The grant award is for Fiscal Year 2022. The funding period is December 1, 2021 – September 30, 2022.

**RFA Release:** The Request for Applications (RFA) will be available electronically beginning <u>Friday</u>, <u>October 8, 2021</u> on the OVSJG website at <u>http://ovsjg.dc.gov</u> and the District's Grant Clearing House website at <u>https://communityaffairs.dc.gov/content/community-grant-program#4</u>. All applications must be submitted to OVSJG's online grants management portal, <u>ZoomGrants</u><sup>TM</sup>.

Application Submission Deadline: Wednesday, November 10, 2021.
