**GreenWrench Education Program**

The Department of Energy and Environment (the Department) seeks applications to conduct environmental education in the District. The grantee would (1) teach pollution prevention (P2) to District high-school-level students studying to be automotive mechanics and (2) green skills training to professional mechanics regarding (a) servicing Electric Vehicles (EVs), and (b) the District's clean transportation plan, and its environmental benefits. The amount available for the project is \$92,000.

- Faith-based organizations;
- Government agencies;
- Universities/educational institutions; and
- Private Enterprises.
