Building Science Energy Education Program

The Department of Energy and Environment (the Department) seeks eligible entities to work with a District vocational high school to create green energy and green building educational content, develop a curriculum, foster hands-on experiences, and connect students with energy professionals and career pathways in the green economy. The amount available for the project is \$60,000, over two years.

The deadline for application submissions is 04-30-2024. The online application must be time-stamped by 11:59 p.m. on the date the application is due.

Eligibility: All the checked institutions below may apply for these grants:

- Nonprofit organizations, including those with IRS 501(c)(3) or 501(c)(4) determinations;
- Faith-based organizations;
- Government agencies;
- Universities/educational institutions; and
- Private Enterprises.
