## NOTICE OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY

### DC Green Cleaning Program

The Department of Energy and Environment (the Department) seeks an eligible entity to launch and develop the District's Green Cleaning Program (GCP). The GCP will support Cleaning Service Providers (CSPs) from the disadvantaged communities of Wards 5, 7, and 8, to transition to safer and more sustainable cleaning products, implement an outreach strategy, build capacity, and make a smoother financial transition to safer and more sustainable cleaning products.

The amount available for the project is \$284,000 for a 24-month period.

Beginning 05-03-2024, the full text of the Request for Applications (RFA) will be available on the Department's website. A person may obtain a copy of this RFA by any of the following means:

- Nonprofit organizations, including those with IRS 501(c)(3) or 501(c)(4) determinations;
- Faith-based organizations;
- Government agencies;
- Universities/educational institutions; and
- Private Enterprises.
