The Department of Energy and Environment (the Department) offers three grants through three separate RFAs to help improve children's long-term asthma control and to reduce COVID-19 transmission in the District's vulnerable low-income communities. Poor indoor and ambient air quality, lack of good information, and substandard housing conditions negatively impact the health of low-income families.

The grantee(s) would address these factors by:

- 1. Conducting virtual home visits with housing and asthma experts;
- 2. Providing program participants with computers, internet access, and technical training; and
- 3. Training staff at childcare facilities.

These separate projects will have \$100,000, \$41,014, and \$20,000 of funding available, respectively.
