NOTICE OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY**

Kingman and Heritage Islands Conservation Area Restoration 2022-24

The Department of Energy and Environment (DOEE) seeks eligible entities to develop a long-term ecological restoration plan for the Kingman and Heritage Islands Conservation Area (“Conservation Area”) and implement the plan’s near-term restoration activities. DOEE wishes to improve the resource and the quality of the public’s experience of the resource.

DOEE expects to award up to \$900,000 to a single applicant/applicant team.

Beginning 6/10/2022, the full text of the Request for Applications (RFA) will be available on the Department’s website. A person may obtain a copy of this RFA by any of the following means:

Download from the Department’s website, www.doe.dc.gov. Select the *Resources* tab. Cursor over the pull-down list and select *Grants and Funding*. On the new page, cursor down to this RFA. Click on *Read More* and download this RFA and related information from the *Attachments* section.

The deadline for application submissions is 7/11/2022. The online application must be time stamped by 11:59 p.m. on the date the application is due.

Eligibility: All the checked institutions below may apply for these grants:

- Nonprofit organizations, including those with IRS 501(c)(3) or 501(c)(4) determinations;
- Faith-based organizations;
- Government agencies;
- Universities/educational institutions; and
- Private Enterprises.
