Green Infrastructure Maintenance

The Department of Energy and Environment (the Department) seeks eligible entities to (1) primarily, provide excellent routine maintenance for 400 GI installed by District agencies and (2) secondarily, create GI maintenance sustainable employment opportunities for local District residents, including Returning Citizens, and foster stewardship and maintenance support opportunities for communities. The grantee will maintain approximately 400 installations per year.

The amount available for the project is approximately \$800,000 per year.

Beginning 08-09-2024, the full text of the Request for Applications (RFA) will be available on the Department’s website. A person may obtain a copy of this RFA by any of the following means:

Eligibility: All the checked institutions below may apply for these grants:

- Nonprofit organizations, including those with IRS 501(c)(3) or 501(c)(4) determinations;
- Faith-based organizations;
- Government agencies;
- Universities/educational institutions; and
- Private Enterprises.

The deadline for application submissions is September 12, 2024. The online application must be time-stamped by 11:59 p.m. on the date the application is due.

DOEE will hold a virtual public meeting on August 13, at 12:00 noon. Details appear in the RFA.
