The Office of Victim Services and Justice Grants (OVSJG) announces the availability of crime victim services grant funding for FY 2023.

Purpose/Description:

Funding is available for development of a Law Enforcement/Hospital Based Violence Intervention Program protocol and training project.

Funding in this RFA includes:

Local funds- up to \$500,000

Eligible Organizations/Entities: Any public or private, community-based non-profit agency, organization, or institution located in the District of Columbia is eligible to apply. For-profit organizations are eligible for local funds but may not include profit in their grant application. For-profit organizations may also participate as subcontractors to eligible agencies.

Length of Award: The grant award is for Fiscal Year 2023. The funding period is February 1, 2023 – September 30, 2023.
