**Diversity, Equity, Inclusion and Justice Strategy for the District’s Municipal Separate  
Storm Sewer System Programs**

DOEE will fund a grantee to develop a strategy to improve diversity, equity, inclusion, and environmental justice in the District’s MS4 permit programs. Development must include meaningful engagement with District residents and other relevant stakeholders. The amount available for the project is \$90,600 over two calendar years.

**The deadline for application submissions is 04-30-2024.** The online application must be time-stamped by 11:59 p.m. on the date the application is due.

**Eligibility:** All the checked institutions below may apply for these grants:

- Nonprofit organizations, including those with IRS 501(c)(3) or 501(c)(4) determinations;
- Faith-based organizations;
- Government agencies;
- Universities/educational institutions; and
- Private Enterprises.
