**Private Fleet Diesel Electrification and Low-NOx (PF DEAL)**

The Department of Energy and Environment (the Department) seeks eligible entities to improve public health by reducing diesel emissions in the District through the replacement of class 5+ medium- or heavy-duty diesel-powered buses with zero emissions vehicle equivalents. DOEE expects to fund at least four vehicles and may award one or more grants. The amount available for the project is approximately \$1,664,750.

Beginning 03/17/2023, the full text of the Request for Applications (RFA) will be available on the Department's website. A person may obtain a copy of this RFA by any of the following means:

- Faith-based organizations;
- Government agencies;
- Universities/educational institutions; and
- Private Enterprises
